
Before reading...

- What is the 'Big Friendly Giant' called for short?
- What is an 'eye-smiler'?
- What does the Big Friendly Giant carry with him?

- Summarise Danny's dad in one word.
- Summarise how you feel after reading about Danny's early-childhood?

2. Cars and Kites and Fire-Balloons & My Father's Deep Dark Secret

- What is Method Number Two'?
- Where does the dad go to do his poaching?
- What was Mr. Hazell's job?

- Summarise Mr. Hazell in one word.
- Summarise the poaching methods in one word.

4. The Baby Austin

Vocabulary

- What is 'doom'?
- What is 'petrified'? Think of a synonym.
- Find an example of onomatopoeia.

Infer

- Why does Danny's dad wear a dark blue sweater?
- Why does Danny think it is 'no good trying to work'?
- What is wrong with the clothes Danny is wearing?
- Why did the car 'bounce and bump' all over the place?
- How does Danny work out how long it would take to do six miles an hour?
- Why did Danny not dare to see if the police were coming after him?

Predict

- What has happened to Dad?
- Will Danny find his dad?

Explain

- How does Dahl make the woods sound scary?
- Did Danny do the right thing by going to find his dad?
- How does Dahl create tension at the end of the chapter?

Retrieve

- What time is 'twilight time'?
- What time does Danny wake up?
- How late is Danny's dad?
- Which way did Danny have to drive to get to Hazell wood?
- How long it would take me to do six miles travelling at fifteen miles an hour.
- What would happen if the police caught Danny?

- How would you feel if you were Danny?
- Summarise this chapter in one word.
