2. The Great Shooting Party & The Sleeping Beauty

3. Thursday and School

- Name three of the teachers.

Summarise

- Describe Captain Lancaster in one word.
- Summarise how the reader feels at the end of these chapters in one word.

4. Friday & Into the Wood

Infer

- Why did Danny dread this day?
- Why did Danny's grandma go poaching with Danny's dad?

- Why did Danny's dad pull the peak of his cap down low over his eyes?
- Why do Danny and his dad have to lie down flat?
- Why was Hazell wood a 'poacher's dream come true'?

Explain

- Why is keep low all the time in italics?
- Is this a clever plan?

Retrieve

- What time did Danny get woken up?
- How long did it take to prepare one raisin?
- How many raisins had been prepared by midday?
- What shoes does Danny take off? What new ones does he put on?
- As well as pheasants, what other birds are in the wood?

Summarise

- Describe the plan in one word.
- Summarise how you would feel if you saw one of the keepers.
