

Writing Lessons

Aims of the lessons

- ★ Equip students with invaluable **writing skills**.
- ★ Teach students how to produce **different forms** of creative writing (i.e. *creative fiction, analytical writing, letters*).
- ★ **Excite and encourage** students to continue reading and practicing their writing skills.
- ★ **Engage** students in **class discussion** to build both the skills as an individual and as a team player.
- ★ Offer students **personalised feedback** and help them **build their strengths** and **improve their weaknesses**.

Lesson Structure

Over the course of the programme we will focus on a **wide variety of different forms of writing**. In the lessons we will **look at examples, learn techniques, brainstorm ideas** as a group, and **complete writing tasks**. Below is an example of what we will be covering over the course of the programme:

- **Lesson 1: *Introduction to writing.***
- **Lesson 2: *Creative writing: continuing a story.***
- **Lesson 3: *Creative writing: using an image as inspiration.***
- **Lesson 4: *Creative writing: writing from a title.***
- **Lesson 5: *Creative writing: writing fantasy stories.***
- **Lesson 6: *Creative writing: writing mystery stories.***
- **Lesson 7: *Writing poetry.***
- **Lesson 8: *Writing a letter.***
- **Lesson 9: *Writing a review.***
- **Lesson 10: *Consolidating and improving our writing skills.***

Homework and assessment

Along with completing tasks during the lessons, students will be set a **homework** task to do for each topic. This work will be **carefully marked** and students will receive **detailed feedback** which will highlight **what they did well, where they can improve, and corrections on spelling and grammar**.
